

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS STRYPER48, STRYPER54, STRYPER60, STRYPER72 Restriping Kits for Clear Acrylic Backboards



## **Bill of Materials**

- (2) Top & Bottom Vinyl Strips (48", 54", 60" or 72")
- (2) Side Vinyl Strips (36" or 42")
- (2) 24" Vinyl Strips (shooter's square)
- (2) 18" Vinyl Strips (shooter's square)
- (1) Application Squeegee

**NOTE:** Applying the strips to the backboard is easier with rim already removed. The steps below refer to rim removal, but if you prefer to leave the rim installed on the backboard, you may need to cut the long bottom perimeter strip and the bottom 24" shooter's square strip to allow relief where the rim sits.

- If you have not already done so, you should first remove the rim from your basketball unit. (optional, see above note) WARNING!! IF NECESSARY, YOU MUST SUPPORT BACKBOARD DURING RIM REMOVAL!! DO NOT ALLOW BACKBOARD TO FALL WHILE REMOVING RIM!!
- 2. Use a damp cloth to remove dust and debris from the face of the backboard to provide a clean surface for maximum vinyl adhesion.
- 3. Dry all moisture from the face of the backboard.
- 4. Remove the "hard" paper backing from one of the vinyl strips and apply it to its respective position using the remnants of the old markings as a reference guide for proper placement location.
- 5. With the strip in place, first rub over the strip using the palm of your hand to make sure the vinyl is in contact with the face of the backboard. Then, rub over the strip using the squeegee to remove any excessive air bubbles.
- 6. Next, slowly peel the flexible paper masking off the strip.
- 7. Trim excess vinyl with sharp knife as needed.
- 8. Repeat steps 4-7 for each of the various strips until the backboard is completely re-striped. NOTE: It does not matter if the vinyl strips overlap each other.
- 9. If necessary, use a sharp knife you will want to cut out the vinyl that covers the top or bottom rim mounting holes in the backboard.
- 10. Re-assemble the rim to your backboard.
